Amendment of Board Policy 7.40 Purchasing Policies and Bidding

- I. This policy provides criteria for authorizing purchases and entering into contracts pursuant to awarded bids.
- II. The proposed revision assures that all necessary affirmative steps to assure that minority businesses, women's business enterprises and labor surplus are firms are used when possible.
- III. Legal authority for this policy is F.S. 1001.41, 1001.42. Laws implemented are 112.312, 119.071, 120.57, 212.08, 212.0821, 255.04, 274.02, 287.017, 287.057, 1001.43, 1010.01, 1010.04, 1013.47 F.S.
- IV. This policy amendment will not affect individuals from an economic standpoint.

Amendment of Code of Student Conduct Board Policy 5.40 Student Control

- I. This policy includes the Code of Student Conduct.
- II. The proposed amendment includes: application of Florida State Statutes when applicable for all school incidents, revision of interventions, addition of threat assessment protocol and publication of safety information from the Marjory Stoneman Douglas Act and formatting and grammatical changes.
- III. Legal authority for this policy is F.S. 1001.41, 1001.42. Laws implemented are F.S. 120.57(1), 1001.43, 1002.20, 1003.04, 1003.21, 1003.31, 1003.32, 1006.07, 1006.08, 1006.09, 1006.10, 1006.13; State Board of Education Rules 6A-1.0404.
- IV. This policy amendment will not affect individuals from an economic standpoint.
