BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Funds from this grant will be used for one paraprofessional at Okeechobee High School to assist in the credit retrieval lab. Title V funds also provide supplemental instructional materials at Okeechobee High School and tutorials at both high school sites. Supplemental materials and services, such as the Reflex Math program at elementary sites, APTT supplies for district implementation, and AVID supplies at the middle and high school level are supported through this project. Also funded by this project budget is 50% of the Graduation Coach position at Okeechobee High School. The funded amount reflects a decrease of \$10,713.00 in comparison to the 2016-17 project year.
