A. PROCLAMATION – MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH

Superintendent's Recommendation: That the Board adopt a proclamation recognizing May 2020, as Mental Health Awareness Month in Okeechobee, Florida.

**PROCLAIMING MAY 2020,  
MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH  
IN OKEECHOBEE, FLORIDA**

**WHEREAS**, good mental health is a key component in a child's healthy development and Children's Mental Health Week provides the opportunity to focus on this important matter, while celebrating the accomplishments of children and families affected by mental health concerns; and

**WHEREAS**, it is important that youth, their families, and communities learn about warning signs of mental health disorders and where to obtain necessary assistance and services; and

**WHEREAS**, open dialogue is an essential component to fight stigma and encourage those who might benefit from services to seek help; and

**WHEREAS**, there is a need for access to comprehensive services that are family-driven, youth guided, culturally and linguistically competent, and community based; they also benefit from the integration of behavioral health in primary care, education, and child welfare; and

**WHEREAS**, it is appropriate that week (May 1<sup>st</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup>) and specifically a day (May 7<sup>th</sup>) should be set apart each year to recognize the importance of our children's mental health and well-being and our responsibility to promote them; and

**WHEREAS**, all citizens, agencies, and organizations interested in advancing innovative strategies addressing children's behavioral health including suicide prevention can unite to promote effective services;

**WHEREAS**, promoting mental health and wellness leads to higher overall productivity, better educational outcomes, lower crime rates, stronger economies, lower health care costs, improved family life, improved quality of life and increased lifespan, and;

**WHEREAS**, studies show that the effects of ACEs are felt by people regardless of race, ethnicity, religion, gender, sexual orientation, or socio-economic status, and;

**WHEREAS**, each business, school, government agency, healthcare provider, faith-based organization, non-profit agency and resident shares accountability for the community's mental health needs and has a responsibility to promote mental wellness and support prevention efforts, and;

**WHEREAS**, Okeechobee County, recognizes the impact of awareness and education, access to services, and acceptance of the importance of mental health and well-being to a person's overall success and supports the implementation of trauma informed approaches throughout the systems of care.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE Okeechobee County School Board in OKEECHOBEE, FLORIDA**, that May 2020, is hereby proclaimed as:

Discussion/Additional Information	Superintendent Kenworthy stated that the revision to Board Policy 4.20 is required to comply with the Commissioner's recommendations for school closure caused by COVID-19, and updates from the Florida Department of Education related to cancellation of state assessments. In addition, Mr. Kenworthy reviewed the latest revision to the plan regarding grades. This language is for 4 <sup>th</sup> quarter grades for the 2019-20 school year. Member Holcomb asked for confirmation that EOCs given at a later date will not affect current grades. Mr. Kenworthy stated that is correct unless the state regulates it later. Vice Chairman Jahner said the revision will help students that are trying, but if students do not try, it would not be right to move them from zero to fifty. Mr. Kenworthy stated that a fifty is still an F and if the student did not do work in the 3 <sup>rd</sup> quarter it would still be an F. It is hard to gauge a student's engagement. Principals are reporting weekly student activity. Superintendent Kenworthy stated that middle school students seem to be struggling more than other grade levels. A variety of circumstances have affected students, including students with disabilities, English as a second language, distance learning (not the right fit for some students), depression, and parents out of work. Advertisement of the intent to amend Student Progression Plan – Board Policy 4.20 was approved by the School Board on April 14, 2020, and legally advertised to the public on April 15, 2020, as required by Chapter 120, Administrative Procedures Act, Florida Statutes.
