VII. <u>Information Items</u>

A. <u>SUPERINTENDENT</u>

- School Start Times Mr. Kenworthy thanked Board members for requesting the Workshop and asked for direction from the Board. Chairman Holcomb stated that after hearing so many cons from staff, parents, and students she is willing to leave the current school start times and is not interested in moving forward beyond the workshop. Member Arnold stated that school grades need monitoring. Where are we and where do we want to be? A later start time will improve grades. Member Arnold said he would like to see student improvement and an "A" district. He stated that there is no simple solution, but would like to see other offerings so that all students perform at their best. Member Morgan agreed but mentioned not being comfortable with the domino effect to other schools if OHS start time is changed. The Board needs to focus on student achievement, what motivates a student, consider absences, and someone to follow students to guide them. Member Riedel asked if another workshop should be considered or should administrators bring ideas to help with student achievement. Member Jahner mentioned that in her campaign she wanted the high school time to change and still thinks the students would benefit. But she is comfortable moving forward with the current school start times and strive to find a solution. Attorney Conely stated that no action will be taken at this meeting.
- Reminded members about the Banquet, January 25, at Osceola Middle School.

- The Legislative Delegation will be held Friday. Mr. Kenworthy said he will present the items previously discussed with Board members.
- Sheriff Stephen notified the District that tonight was the first night for Guardian training. The training will continue for the next two months to complete the required 144 hours.

B. SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS

- Chairman Holcomb announced that she will be at FSBIT and will not be at the Legislative Delegation.
- Chairman Holcomb asked if the Board was interested in Master Board Training. Member Arnold stated that it strengthens the Board. Member Riedel stated that she too was in favor. A recommendation will be added to the February Agenda for consideration.
- Member Arnold reminded members that the Legislative session will soon start and to reach out to members.

C. SCHOOL BOARD ATTORNEY

 Announced that he recently attended the County Commission meeting on another matter and was very proud to see another governmental agency recognize OHS CTE students for their Thanksgiving dinner project.

D. PUBLIC

• Principal Tedders stated that OHS has a lot to offer students. Many students have the drive, some without parental support, to enroll in Harvard and be elected the State FFA President. The Talented 20 comes from one school in Okeechobee – OHS. OHS cannot offer everything, but it does offer what a student needs to move on to their next path. Mr. Kenworthy reminded Board members that the Strategic Plan is the plan to give the Board direction. The Board has mentioned new visioning. Should an agency be hired to direct that process? The School Improvement Plans work towards the Strategic Plan, that venue is the method for improvement. The graduation rate is up 5% and we need to continue to work on that number. Okeechobee has a higher percentage of students gainfully employed or attending college according to FETPIP. Member Arnold stressed the importance of all students reading on grade level by third grade.
