Amendment of Board Policy 3.70 Flag Display and Pledge

- I. This policy defines flag display and pledge participation.
- II. The proposed amendment reflects current requirements in 1003.44, Florida Statutes.
- III. Legal authority for this policy is F.S. 1001.41, 1001.42. Laws implemented are F.S. 256.015, 1000.06, 1000.21, 1001.43, 1002.20, 1003.42, 1003.44.
- IV. This policy amendment will not affect individuals from an economic standpoint.

Adoption of Board Policy 4.26 Grade Forgiveness

- I. This policy provides guidance to assist students in meeting graduation requirements.
- II. The proposed policy is required by statute to address grade forgiveness.
- III. Legal authority for this policy is F.S. 1001.41, 1001.42. Laws implemented are F.S. 1001.43, 1003.4156, 1003.4281, 1003.4282; 1003.437, 1003.49, 1008.25; State Board of Education Rules 6A-1.0955.
- IV. This policy amendment will not affect individuals from an economic standpoint.

Adoption of Board Policy 4.48 Virtual Instruction

- I. This policy provides guidance for one (1) course through online learning for graduation.
- II. The proposed policy is required by statute to address a virtual instruction graduation requirement.
- III. Legal authority for this policy is F.S. 1001.41, 1001.42. Laws implemented are F.S. 1002.37, 1002.45, 1002.455, 103.02, 1003.4282, 1003.498, 1006.29, 1007.27, 1011.62. State Board of Education Rules: 6A-6.0981, 6A-6.0982
- IV. This policy amendment will not affect individuals from an economic standpoint.
