Phase 1 consists of envelope improvements to 355,686 sf of space including Building 8 and HVAC improvements for Buildings 1 and 3 and safety and security improvements for Building 99 on the Cypress Bay High School campus, Phase 2 consists of construction of a new 82,000 sf three story classroom building on the high school campus which will house 61 education spaces for grades 9-12. Work also includes associated site work, utilities and selected off-site work.

This project has been let out in two phases to allow the renovation and improvement work to begin while the new classroom addition was finishing design and permitting. The new classroom building is designed to resemble the school's lightning bolt logo when viewed from above with two distinct kinks in the building. This adds complexity and coordination to construct this unique design.



PROJECT SYNOPSIS



The safety and security of the students is our top priority. With 50 percent of Morganti's workload taking place on active school campuses, great efforts have been made to ensure compliance with the Jessica Lunsford Act. Since the bill was passed in the mid 2000's

Morganti has been enforcing these standards within our own staff and the staff of all subcontractors on site. Criminal background checks are required by all subcontractor for each of their members on site. Once an individual has been cleared they receive a sticker on their hard hat allowing them entrance to the job-site.

Further, all site foremen and project managers are required to participate in regular safety and awareness training, including OSHA 10 and OSHA 30 training. Morganti makes good use of the services offered by AON and their Insurance Carrier by conducting both scheduled and random safety visits and inspections; valuing the constructive feedback offered; and implementing the safety recommendations when provided.

This process creates a safe and secure environment, avoiding injury, property damage, lost productivity and occupational illnesses, and in the end, this commitment to safety and security is evident in our OSHA incident rate. In the last five years, Morganti has achieved an OSHA incident rate of zero (0). Because of Morganti's active management of its safety program and the positive trend of its claim experience The Morganti Group's EMR for 2021 is .77.




Jupiter Community High School Replacement




PHASE 1 SITE


ID PREPAREDNESS

At Morganti, we prepare, and we care. These are the basic tenets of our COVID-19 site preparedness plan, which incorporates a three pronged approach to protecting our on-site staff, subcontractors, and project owners and team members.


Managed by the on-site *Covid Coordinator* Morganti minimizes exposure by having a single point of entry to each project site with thermal scanning at the entrances. Trades are not stacked, and work crews are limited to no more than two or three people working together with no switching during the day. Finally, social distancing recommendations (six feet) are maintained during physical construction work and during daily on-site meetings whenever possible, and all on-site personnel are required to wear proper PPE and face masks.

Enforce strict hygiene Educate our on-site through hand washing Minimize exposure by staff and subcontractors having a single point of stations, social distancing and during daily Toolbox Safety disinfecting all common entry. **Talks** areas

As an added layer of protection for Morganti's on-site staff and subcontractors, all subcontractors have a member on our on-site COVID-19 response team, and prior to mobilization, subcontractors are required to submit their own COVID-19 field plans for approval. Utilization of these steps has been effective in greatly eliminating Covid on all job sites.

SPECIAL FACILITY CONSTRUCTION **ACCOUNT**

Having spent the past five decades building K-12 facilities across Florida, the Morganti team has constructed numerous projects that were funded by the PECO program.

Morganti acknowledges that funding for the high school was achieved through FS 1013.64 (Special facilities Construction Account). In light of that we are also are aware that historically this statutory provision could mandate as much as a 3 year phasing. It is our understanding that your funding was not phased but was funded in full with federal CARES money being a contingency. In any event we will proceed as determined by the district and DOE.

Additionally we are aware that accepting these funds mandates that student seat allocations are capped. Accordingly we will work with CRA Architects to assure that construction will meet this requirement.





What is the Special Facility Construction Account?

The Special Facility Construction Account is funded with Public Education Capital Outlay (PECO)1 dollars and provides construction funds to school districts that have urgent construction needs but lack sufficient resources and cannot reasonably anticipate sufficient resources within three years in order to fund these construction needs. Typically, small, rural school districts qualify for this funding because their property tax values are too low to fund a new construction

Are there limits on the number of construction projects for which a school district may receive funding from the Special Facility **Construction Account?**

Yes. A school district is not eligible to receive funding from the Special Facility Construction Account for more than one construction project during any three-year period.

Does a school district have to meet certain criteria in order to receive funds from the Special Facility Construction Account?

Yes. A school district must meet the following criteria in order to receive funds from the Special Facility Construction Account:

- The construction project must be deemed a critical need and must be recommended for funding by the Special Facility Construction Committee.⁵
- The construction project must be recommended in the most recent educational plant survey.⁶
- The construction project must appear on the district's approved project priority list.

⁵ The Special Facility Construction Committee is composed of two representatives of the Department of Education, a representative from the Governor's office, a representative selected annually by the district school boards, and a representative selected annually by the superintendents. The committee reviews the requests submitted from the districts, evaluates the ability of the project to relieve critical needs, and ranks the requests in priority order. This statewide priority list for special facilities construction is submitted to the Legislature in the commissioner's annual capital outlay legislative budget request at least 45 days prior to the legislative session. 




PHASED HIGH SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION-BUDGET TRACKING
