V. Information Items

A. SUPERINTENDENT

- At the July 11 Board meeting, Member Arnold requested procedures for the new Challenge to Instructional Materials policy be brought to this meeting. Mr. Kenworthy invited Mrs. McCoy to the podium. Mrs. McCoy distributed the current policy 4.43, Request for Reconsideration of Instructional Materials form and Proposed Changes to Policy 4.43 from HB 989. Mrs. McCoy reviewed the proposed changes, in addition she contacted DOE, DOE is working on this issue. Superintendent Kenworthy stated that Jerry Copeland's company formerly provided the District with new policy language and has been bought out by NEFEC. NEFEC stated the first release of new policy language will probably be released October 15, 2017.
- The Superintendent shared information regarding safety and the eclipse with Board members. Schools around the state are taking various safety precautions such as early release, extended day, moving students and activities indoors, shifting the school day and maintaining a regular schedule. Member Arnold stated this should be an Administrative decision, not a Board decision. Members agreed this is a good educational opportunity with proper communication and safety precautions. Mr. Kenworthy stated the District would maintain regular school hours, move activities indoors during the time of the eclipse, offer free modified after-care at all elementary schools, send a letter home outlining the District's plan and safety information, as well as phone, social media and e-mail communication to parents and quardians.
- Mr. Kenworthy thanked Board members and members of the audience for writing letters
 and traveling to Tallahassee in support of the Special Facilities meeting. The outcome was
 not in favor of the project. Chairman Morgan thanked OHS student, C. Rios, present in
 the audience, for the letter he wrote, she stated that she read his letter to members of the
 committee in Tallahassee.

B. SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS

- Member Arnold announced that he has been in conversation with Rep. Albrittion. He
 encouraged members to be visable and contact current and potential members of the
 House and Senate regarding Special Facilities.
- Chairman Morgan said that Charles Murphy has been a great friend to the Board and Okeechobee and will truly be missed. The Superintendnet stated that Charles will be leaving for Alaska on August 24, and that he was sorry Charles was no longer present to be recognized by the District and Board.
- · Member Arnold asked what Glades County did when they were originally turned down for

Special Facilities and can we appeal? The Superintendent stated that he was told about their pre-application process, they were turned down, Glades County went back to Tallahassee and the next week they were approved. The Superintendent will follow up on the appeals process.

C. SCHOOL BOARD ATTORNEY

- Announced that mediation will be set up with the ESE issue, probably in late August. This
 case is complicated, but hopefully can be resolved in mediation, if not, it will go to a
 DOAH hearing.
