III. Transportation Presentation

Nicole Havee, Supervisor of Transportation

Supervisor Havee shared with the Board information from the Transportation Department. On August 2, transportation staff along with first responders and the Health Department held a mock bus accident. After completing the on-scene training, the bus drivers continued their educational session at Indian River State College. A survey of the number of times a bus was passed while stopped was conducted May 2016. Ms. Havee reported that seventeen buses were passed a total of thirty-seven times. Most of the incidents happened on major arteries, including Hwy. 70, 441, 98 and 710. The local fine for passing a bus is \$250. Other states have different fines, some higher and some states include jail time.

Ms. Havee stated the new routing software, Info Router, is working well. When a student, in the Skyward System, identifies himself, the information is typed into the software and the program provides the routing information. This program has reduced the number of routes from 48 (41 regular and 7 special education) to 46 routes (40 regular and 6 special education). The reduction in routes will save 37,800 miles this school year. Superintendent Kenworthy said that he noticed a remarkable difference in the length of the lines waiting for bus information at Open House. He credited it to the Info Router program.
